The 13th Annual Genomics of Energy & Environment Meeting, hosted by the Department of Energy Joint Genome Institute, is the premier meeting that brings together those from the scientific community who focus on environmental integrative genome science. We expect the event to draw some 650 participants from universities, companies, and national laboratories from around the world — high-profile researchers, educators, and students alike — pursuing frontier energy and environmental genomics research, technology development and education.

The formal meeting is preceded by workshops which take place on Tuesday, March 13 and Wednesday, March 14.

Parallel tracks and workshops include:

In parallel with the main Meeting, the JGI will host the first ever Viral EcoGenomics and Applications (VEGA) Symposium 2018. In addition, workshops focused on genomic technologies, genomics of microbes, metagenomes, fungi, and plants as well as the DOE Systems Knowledgebase (KBase) will precede the Symposium and plenary sessions.

The Meeting opening keynote address is at 5pm on Wednesday March 14, followed by the first poster session reception. The main sessions take place all day Thursday, March 15 through Friday, March 16.
